## 2008 ---Is finally is bringing completion of CONA improvements

1. **CONA Traffic Calming projects** are finally headed to construction. After years of delays, designs, re-designs and cost over runs they will start construction beginning in February.
2. **Driveway approaches** The final phase of new driveway approaches are now in the process of being constructed. There are **five empty slots** left in this budget. **Property owners with an existing concrete rolled curb not** on the approved list desiring to be added must contact the association immediately (approved list is in the July 2007 newsletter, available online at [www.cona.info](http://www.cona.info)). The new approaches may increase the possibility of flooded garages for those who have experienced that problem in the past.
3. **CONA neighborhood entry signs** have been received and are being installed in the next few weeks..
4. **Street trees are still available.** If you would like a Liquid Amber or Cork Oak in the city easement (within 12' from the curb) please call or email.

### AT CONA's request the Monterey City Council passed a resolution supporting residents concerns regarding Airport impacts.

1. **Last September the Monterey City Council passed** by a unanimous vote a resolution recommending that the Airport District address residents concerns over a night curfew, ground noise and aircraft over flights. Our next newsletter will go into detail on how this groundbreaking resolution will help.
2. **Please note** that the City of Monterey access channel 25 is currently announcing that Monterey Police will be enforcing state codes requiring that sidewalks be accessible. They are citing drivers who block sidewalks with their cars.
