## 2010

We are facing a very difficult year. The Monterey City Council has stated that our city is facing a current \$1.7 million dollar deficit and a projected deficit for the coming year of \$3.6 million for a total of \$5.3 million dollars which must be cut from the city budget. This estimate is assuming the downturn is stable and does not get worse. For the first time in history, the Council recommended that the Neighborhood Improvement Program be deferred next year and that its funding go to this emergency. The Neighborhood Improvement Program Committee, after seeing the economic figures, concurred with the Council; there will not be an NIP this year.

All the previously approved neighborhood traffic calming projects were put on indefinite hold last year in anticipation of the economic emergency. They will remain that way until it is determined that the City does not need the money for further economic downturns.

Neighborhood progress is going to be slowed for a while and city services will be cut back. This winter's storms pose other problems for our area. Individually we must renew our efforts to prepare for the unknown. Please look at how well you are prepared for your family. First, water, two weeks supply is what is now recommended, same for food. Check that you also have that amount in medication, batteries, tarps, etc. Most important of all take the CERT training!

**Please consider taking the free CERT (Community Emergency Response Team) training. In an emergency, it will help keep your family safe. Check the box on the other side!
