APPROVED NOISE ABATEMENT PROCEDURES

VOLUNTARY CURFEW HOURS FROM 2300-0700 HRS. (LOCAL TIME): Aircraft operations are discouraged due to noise sensitive community.

NOISE ABATEMENT PROCEDURES **DO NOT** SUPERCEDE **MONTEREY ATC** DIRECTIONS OR SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS.

Noise sensitive residential and commercial areas surround Monterey Airport. Pilots are asked to **FLY Neighborly** by observing the following noise abatement procedures when safety, weather and/or traffic conditions permit. Use your quietest departure techniques and follow published pattern altitudes and procedures. Low passes, formation arrivals and departures and overhead patterns are prohibited.

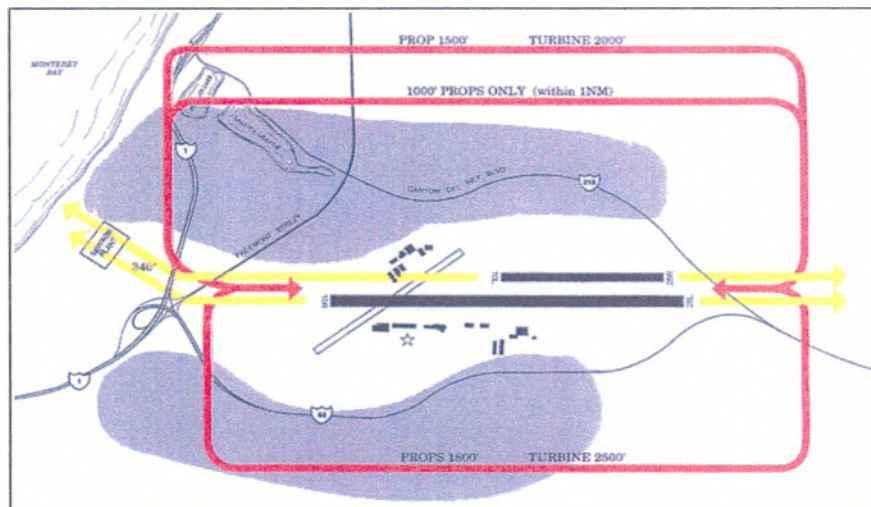
PREFERENTIAL RUNWAY (RWY):

ARRIVALS - RWY 28L/R

DEPARTURES - RWY 10R/L

VFR Procedures:

- **ARRIVALS from or DEPARTURES to the WEST** utilize Monterey Bay's over-water route when possible.
- **COMMENCE TURNS** following departure after reaching an altitude of 900 Feet AGL and/or passing over HWY 1 when departing **RWY 28 L/R**.



TRAFFIC PATTERN ALTITUDES:

NORTH PATTERN	Propeller	1500' AGL	Turbine	2000' AGL
NORTH CLOSED PATTERN (Within one mile RWY 28R/10L)	(Only) Propeller	1000' AGL	Turbine	N/A
SOUTH PATTERN	Propeller	1800' AGL	Turbine	2500' AGL

HELICOPTERS follow fixed wing patterns and avoid residential areas adjacent to the airport.

TOUCH AND GO OPERATIONS: **NO touch and go operation for ANY turbo jet aircraft or turbo prop aircraft larger than a King Air (C-12).** Limited to the hours of 0830-2000 hrs., Monday through Friday, and 0900-1800 hrs., Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays. Touch and Go Operations restricted to four within a two-hour period.

PRACTICE APPROACH: (DISCOURAGED) Limit of two practice approaches for aircraft larger than a King Air. On missed practice approach fly length of **RWY 10R** before turning north. Discontinue approach west of the shoreline and remain over water if unable to over fly airport.

EXCEPTIONS:

- Emergencies
- Necessary Military Operations
- Stage 3 aircraft
- Commercial Carriers meeting Stage 3 requirements
- Non-stage 3 aircraft delayed due to weather, equipment, or other operational problems beyond reasonable control.

DURING CURFEW HOURS:

- **Landings** are limited to **RWY 28L** unless conditions dictate otherwise.
- **Take-Offs** are limited to **RWY 10R** unless conditions dictate otherwise.
