Guest speakers: Tom Greer – Airport manager & Jim Buckhorn - FAA representative

This meeting is being held at the request of the new Airport manager, Tom Greer. He would like to get to know our residents and their concerns. Jim Buckhorn, manager of air traffic for the FAA will join Tom at the meeting.

Our association has had comments relayed to us since the plane crash on the Navy golf course a couple of months ago. We had a meeting with the Mayor and City Manager who then held a meeting with the FAA and the Airport concerning small aircraft over

flights of our homes. **Now they need to hear from you!**

This brings to three the number of crashes near us in the last few years, Del Rey Oaks on Rosita, in front of Tarpey's restaurant, and now this one on the Navy golf course. Whatever number of planes we can divert from over our homes will be a direct increase in safety to residents.

Topics for the meeting will include: over flights of both small aircraft and helicopters, development of the new northside, traffic impacts, a

proposed 6 story auto showcase, airport noise impacts, and any others you may wish to discuss.

CONA has a new airport committee chairman, Peter Gustaitis. Pete will be monitoring the meetings at the airport and keep us aware of this changing situation. He will also be able to convey the association and our member's concerns to the Airport District.

Please make time for the meeting. We have set aside one full hour for questions and answers to be sure that everyone has an opportunity to speak.

Airport road drainage construction!

This delayed project is about to start! It was delayed because there was nowhere for the water to go. It depended upon a new system for N. Fremont Street. That is now under construction. The project is start-

ing at the Navy Lake and will work backward to Airport at Edinburgh.

Construction on Airport Road is slated to begin at the end of December and finish in the month of January.

The project is designed to reduce flooding on the lower sides of Edin-

burgh and Lerwick. There will be reduced flooding on N. Fremont at Ramona. A short section of drain will be installed on Lerwick diverting water to the Navy Lake.
