CONA Board Parking Concerns

***Questions are from CONA Board, answers are from the City Parking Division

Q: Who pays for parking enforcement during Fairgrounds events?

A: Historically, Fairgrounds event promoters have covered those costs. Possibly proposed alternative is an annual fee to the residents per car

Q: Why do we follow the same fee structure as year-round programs when ours is eventdriven?

A: The City wants consistent rules citywide, but recognizes CONA may need a unique, event-based program. Residents' feedback will shape this decision.

Q: What about paid parking on Fairgrounds Road and Casa Verde?

A: Paid parking on Fairgrounds Road is being evaluated as a year-round program. The City acknowledges this could increase event-time parking pressure on CONA streets.

Q: Why is there an 85% requirement for resident approval?

A: The 85% threshold is meant to confirm strong neighborhood support, not to end the program. If residents feel that number is too high, they can share feedback with the City Council.

Q: What about multi-vehicle households?

A: The City recognizes costs are a concern for families with several vehicles.

Residents have voiced that event promoters should continue to share program costs, and that will remain part of the discussion.
